When you start to install, you get error 1327, which references an invalid drive number.

Causes:

The System Registry may be erroneously pointing to a temp drive.

Solution:

Back up your Registry.

Select Start > Run > and then type Regedit.

Navigate to the following folder:

 $HKEY_CURRENT_USER \setminus Software \setminus Microsoft \setminus Windows \mid Current \lor Version \setminus Explorer \setminus User \cdot Shell$

In the right panel, search for entries that list the incorrect drive.

Modify the incorrect drive to point to C:\.
